
## 3D Blob Cats



Inspired from the "blob cats reels" in social media, we have enjoyed adding another layer to the fun.

Materials needed: Hot glue gun, black paint (also can use a colour you'd prefer), watercolour paints, paper, brushes, plastic material (for hot glue drawing pad), scraps of paper, black pens.

<u>Note:</u> If using a hot glue gun make sure you're careful when handling it and wait till glue has cooled to pick off.



Create your own 2D blob cats, either paint blob or scribble like marks on a page with watercolours (left image) or spend time wetting the page then layer splashes of colours then dripping different paints on to a page (right image).

When dry simply draw any felines you see in the blobs. Like cloud gazing to find shapes.



Using a hot glue gun simply draw on the plastic sheet, using a cat from your picture you created earlier.

When drawing the cat, make sure all the parts connect, like eyes to the sides of its head, then around the ears, to feet and the tail.

Make sure to go over lines with the hot glue to make them sturdier.

Leave to cool and make more cats.





When cooled, then you can spend your time picking off the glue, try to take it off all connected, but sometimes they break, luckily you can just glue bits back together.

Paint your cat an opaque colour, we used black for our hot glue contour lines. When covered leave to dry.





Now explore what would be fun to place your blob cat shapes in front of.

We crumpled up some scrap paper and placed them in front, or placed over flowers, or on our chair.

Excited to see what you create.
